All soul owners have an explicit or hidden craving for the sublime.




A green idea is good as long as we don't start to drive it to the point of absurdity.


Sometimes, it takes a lifetime to figure out what is really worth something in this world,

The beauty of our world with its millions of wonderful places proves the beauty of their Creator.




People, by their very nature, often remain children. Only their toys get bigger and more expensive over the years. Those who outgrow earthly toys really grow up.
